1. NV Champagne Vilmart & Cie Grande Reserve Premier Cru Brut, Rilly la Montagne, Reims. The pale colour with traces of silver announce a majority of Pinot Noir with an excellent maturity. It's followed by a delicate effervescence. The fine bubbles, persistent and its elegance to the surface. The first impression on the nose, is marked by a great intensity. It will open up on a rich bouquet of pastries, with notes of frangipane and honeysuckle, with attractive aromas of pepper mint flagrance	WS 93	108	588

4. 2020 Domaine Zind-Humbrect, Riesling Roche Granitique, Alsace, France. Flinty reduction and lemony zestiness create a very appetizing nose. The palate delvers more of those zesty, juicy, mouth-watering lemon notes while the full, rounded body adds a stony depth to those ripe Amalfi lemon flavors.
